## Beech Wood Coat Stand

Instructions for Assembly and Use For permanent use

- Please keep this sheet in a safe place for future reference.


**Caution** **Please read these instructions carefully before assembly**

- \* Make sure there is enough space to assemble the stand. Protect the floor or any furniture from damage by putting down a rug or similar covering.
- \* It is recommended that more than one person assembles the stand.

**Caution** **Precautions after assembling**

- \* About a week after assembling, retighten the hook and leg parts.
- \* Periodically check and tighten any loose screws at the hook and leg parts to ensure safety.
- \* Please read the Precautions for Use carefully to ensure correct use of the stand.


### Precautions for Use

**Caution**


- Always evenly distribute garments or items to be hung. Too many items on one side may cause the stand to topple over and damage the stand, floor or other furniture, or cause injury.
- Do not use the product for any other purpose than its intended use.
- Do not hang anything heavier than normal coats or garments on the hook; too much weight may cause the stand to topple over and damage the stand, floor or other furniture, or cause injury.
- During use, do not step on or stress the leg of the product, this may cause breakage or injury.
- Do not climb or hang on the stand; this may result in breakage or cause the stand to topple over and damage the stand, floor or other furniture, or cause injury. Do not let small children play on or near the stand.

### How to assemble

- 1** Check all the parts against the list before assembling.
- Fix the 03, 04 and 05 hooks on the 01 pole: upper part, in the correct holes as shown in the drawing. Screw the 3 same size hooks straight into the bolt holes at each level on the pole.



- 2** Screw and fix the 06, 07 and 08 legs on the 02 pole: lower part, in the correct holes as shown in the drawing.




**Caution Please be careful!**

- Be careful to choose the correct location for each of the legs. Make sure that the large, middle, small size legs are fixed in their correct locations.

- 3** Combine the two halves assembled in step 1 and 2. Put the 09 gasket in between and turn the upper pole to tighten it. Make sure that the pole is screwed in the upright position. Stop turning the pole when the hooks point in the same direction as the legs as shown in the diagram below.

**Positional relationship between the hooks and the legs**

The 03 and 05 hooks and the 06, 07 and 08 legs must be positioned in the same straight line when viewed from above.




**Load resistance**

Make sure that the load is evenly distributed.

- Maximum 5kg or less
- Maximum 5kg or less
- Maximum 5kg or less
- Maximum 15kg or less

\* If the "Tray for Beech Wood Coat Stand," a separately sold item, is to be added, make sure the total load does not exceed the total capacity of 15 kg for proper use.

- 4** Attach 10 slip stoppers to the "floor-contact area" of each leg. First, firmly screw the legs into the pole until they stop. Then, attach the slip stoppers to the underside of each leg. (Be sure to attach them to all three legs.)



**Caution**

- Using the product without the slip stopper attached to the legs may damage the product or cause injury.
